June 10, 2024

- I. Call to Order –
Mayor Lutitia Ford called the regular meeting of the Bryson City Council to order at 7:00 pm June 10, 2024, in City Hall.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance/Invocation
- III. Roll Call
The following persons were present: Mayor Lutitia Ford, Ald. Shelly Tinney, Ald. Heather Neer, Ald. JR Stearns, Ald. Jesse Laine, Ald. Travis Rhoten, PWD Brian Rushin, City Secretary Cheryl Adams and Visitor Peggy Applewhite. Absent was Ald. Shelly Tinney.
- IV. Visitor Peggy Applewhite addressed the Council concerning the proper display of the American flag at the City Park. She provided information and print outs detailing the proper way to display the flag.
- V. Motion was made to approve the consent agenda including all bills as presented and minutes for the May 14, 2024, Regular Meeting by Jesse Laine; seconded by Ald. JR Stearns. Vote 4-0.
- VI. Discussion was made on weed & debris actions. The council asked if notification letters could be sent without an inspection by TCG. City Secretary Cheryl Adams will send an inquiry to TCG about this.
- VII. Motion was made to request action for debris cleanup by TCG for multiple properties on Locust Street by Ald. JR Stearns, seconded by Ald. Heather Neer. Vote 4-0.
- VIII. Discussion was made regarding Waste Connections change of residential polycart pick up day from Thursdays to Tuesdays beginning July 9, 2024. The council asks to check to make sure it is for polycarts only. City Secretary Cheryl Adams will verify with Waste Connections.
- IX. Discussion was made on the city mural. McCool Design Co. did not begin work on June 1, 2024, as planned. Shelly Tinney sent McCool an email on 6-10. The topic will be readdressed at July's City Council meeting.
- X. Report from Public Works Director – PWD Brian Rushin notified the Council that a new sewer camera had been purchased. Briefly discussed need/costs for additional water storage.
- XI. Report from City Secretary – Discussed new credit card processing system that is planned to be fully implemented by July 1. Discussed need to network office computers of City Secretary and Public Works Director to facilitate the use of RVS software for Lead and Copper testing.
- XII. Adjournment – There being no further business before the Council, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 pm by Ald. JR Stearns; seconded by Ald. Jesse Laine. Vote 4-0.
